SeaHunter's hull design is made for open seas and runs about 10 to 15 percent faster than regular V-bottom or stepped hulls. A sharp entry of 60 degrees and deadrise at the transom of 24.5 combined with oversized chines provides a smooth, dry ride at any speed. SeaHunter achieves this with a full, padded V-bottom with a stepped transom. The hull also is designed specifically for optimal depth finder performance at any speed. VIKING 92 CONVERTIBLE

Launched in late summer, Viking's new flagship, their 92 Convertible, will be available in Open Bridge and Enclosed Bridge configurations. This new model features a stunning profile in either version with several motor yacht amenities including dual mezzanine decks -- one in the cockpit and the second on the main level after deck. The latter mezzanine offers both rear-facing lounge seating, along with a second seating area and a table for dining. An outside galley and grilling area also provided. The yacht's interior is blend of elegance and luxury. The 24-foot beam opens the salon to create massive living room with built-in furniture and luxurious appointments, including a 55-inch flat screen television that's concealed in walnut cabinetry. An L-shape island in the massive galley sports countertops of custom-selected granite. A walkin pantry and a full day head are forward while to port there's a formal dining area that accommodates six.

The 92 Convertible features six staterooms, each with its own private head and shower. The full beam master suite features a king-size walk-around bed, a walk-in closet, a dressing table, and his and her private facilities. Crew's quarters are aft with access from the cockpit and this full beam area includes a head with a shower, a small galley area, and upper and lower berths in a private cabin. Power options available include Caterpillar and MTU engines while communication, navigation and entertainment electronic packages will be designed and installed by Viking's sister company, Atlantic Marine Electronics.
